CINCINNATI, OH –January [date], 2013– Announcing the 36th Annual Ault Park Concours d' Elegance, Sunday, June 9, 2013, featuring *Porsche: From Road to Racing*. Special displays feature 100 years of Aston Martin and 60 years of Corvette. The show will also include thirteen classes of classic, vintage and exotic automobiles, and motorcycles.

The 2013 event co-chairs are Dave Sheehy and Mark Fisk. Fisk and Sheehy have co- chaired the Ault Park Concours together on three previous occasions. Mr. Sheehy is a life-long car enthusiast, with nearly twenty-five years of volunteer service to the Ault Park Concours. Sheehy has served as Chairman of the Ault Park Concours Car Selection for nearly twenty of those years, and has co-chaired the Ault Park Concours on eight occasions. His board leadership includes the Board of Trustees for The Arthritis Foundation, the Show's beneficiary. In 1996 Mr. Sheehy was recognized with the Ohio River Valley Arthritis Foundation Chapter Chairman's Award for his commitment to the Ault Park Concours and the Foundation's mission. Sheehy is currently Board Chairman of the Cincinnati Concours Foundation, the 501(c) 3 organization which operates the Ault Park Concours d'Elegance. Mr. Fisk has been involved with the Ault Park Concours in a variety of capacities for over two decades and is currently serving as Vice-President of the Cincinnati Concours Foundation Board. He is passionate about Porsches, having owned and restored a number of vintage Porsches throughout his life. He is currently restoring a 1961 Porsche 356.
